**1. Sacred Treasure: Our Time**

Stephen Covey's Time Quadrant explanation

	URGENT	NOT URGENT
IMPORTANT	<u>Quadrant I</u> <i>urgent and important</i>	<u>Quadrant II</u> <i>not urgent but important</i>
NOT IMPORTANT	<u>Quadrant III</u> <i>urgent but not important</i>	<u>Quadrant IV</u> <i>not urgent and not important</i>

Breaking Down examples for each quadrant:

- I. Urgent/Important
- II. Not Urgent/Important
- III. Not Important/Urgent
- IV. Not Urgent Not Important

## 2. Love is spelled T-I-M-E

Rock-Pebbles-Sand-Water Analogy

- *The things that we love tell us what we are.” St. Thomas Aquinas*
- *“No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon.” (Luke 16: 12-13. Gospel 9/22)*
- God owns it all. Our money AND our time.
- He is trusting us to do a good job with this gift of time we have. Are we honoring Him well with it?

Parable of Lazarus and rich man (Gospel of Luke 16:19-31, Mass 9/29/19)

- Now, let’s assume the rich man was a rich woman. If she could go back . . . what warnings would she want to give her five sisters?

*“But, you, woman of God, pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness. Compete well for the faith. Lay hold of eternal life, to which you were called.” 1Tim 6:11-12 (2<sup>nd</sup> Reading Mass 9/29).*

- This bible verse . . . what we are choosing to pursue in our gift of time?
- We must pursue taking the time to be loved by the Father.
- That must be one of the big rocks we put in our container.

## 3. Lies of the Enemy that keep us from God’s Love

Lies: “ You are so busy. You can just pray later”

Lies: “God does not hear you. You may not even feel anything different after prayer. Just skip.”

Lies: “Your prayer is too messy. It is not holy enough. Just skip it.”

- God just wants to love on you in the midst of your mess. Even if you are thinking about making dinner during that rosary . . . He is still embracing you in that 15 minutes.
- If you are coming to the Father with a heart of purity and complete focus . . . or one of deep sin, shame, and distraction . . . the Father just wants to love on you.
- Parable of the Prodigal Son: Gospel of Luke 15:1-32 (Mass 9/15/19)
  - Son takes the inheritance, messes up, realizes his mistakes and decides to come back home. He rehearses his apology to his father and then returns home . . . “While he was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him, and was filled with compassion. He ran to his son, embraced him and kissed him. His son said to him, ‘Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you; I no longer deserve to be called your son.’ But his father ordered his servants, ‘Quickly bring the finest robe and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. Take the fattened calf and slaughter it. Then let us celebrate with a feast, because this son of mine was dead, and has come to life again; he was lost, and has been found. Then the celebration began.”
  - The father has been waiting. He sees him from far away and embraces him. When the son begins his apology, his father INTERRUPTS his it to discuss the ways celebrate his sons return. THAT is how your Heavenly Father loves. Let the celebration begin.
  - *“The saints did not all begin well, but they ended well.” St. John Vianney*
